**MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Students must have completed at least 20 transferable (to the University) semester units at the community college, including English 101A.
2. Students must have at least a 2.4 GPA in the transferable course work.
3. Students must have completed any prerequisite courses necessary to the course they wish to take at the University.
4. Each student may enroll for only one course per semester at the four-year institution.
5. Students must have declared an intention to pursue further study at a four-year institution.
6. Students must be recommended for concurrent enrollment by a counselor in the home institution.
7. Students must be considered full-time students by regulations of their home institution, including the units for the one course they will be permitted at the University during any academic period.
8. Students shall take part in an orientation session at the home campus covering all aspects of their concurrent enrollment.
9. Former UC students (officially admitted to the University of California) are not permitted to participate in this program. Students having attended only UC Summer Session (not officially admitted to the University of California) will not be excluded from the program if they meet all admissions criteria.
10. Individuals who have attended a four-year institution (as regular admits) or holding a bachelor's degree (or equivalent from a foreign institution) are not eligible to participate in this program.
11. Students will be permitted to enroll concurrently at the University for each academic period during which they continue studies at the home institution for a maximum of two University terms, provided further that they continue to meet all admissions criteria as previously noted and have a grade of "C" or better in the University course work. (Please note: "C-" will disqualify a student from further participation in the program.)
12. A student who receives an incomplete in University coursework is not allowed to continue in this program until the work for the incomplete is completed and the grade is changed to at least a "C".
