The same form (Transcript/General Education Request Form) can be used for both such requests and is available at the Office of Admissions and Records.</p> <p>After completing and being certified for the 39 lower division units, the student's upper division general education will be basically determined by the difference between the lower division units completed in each area and the total units required by the bachelor degree-granting state university or college.</p> <p>The CSU campus may not accept the certification if fewer than 24 general education units are completed before transfer.</p>
