The Department of Foreign Languages provides instruction in Arabic, Chinese, French, Japanese and Spanish. We have transfer agreements with the California State Colleges and UC. We foster an international environment by including instruction in the target culture and literature as well as the language. We also offer an AAT in Spanish, and conversational Spanish for those students who are more concerned with personal enrichment than with transferring to a 4 year college.

- Student will demonstrate a basic knowledge of target cultures.
- Student will demonstrate a functional and grammatical fluency, both written and oral as well as reading and listening comprehension, in the target language.

3. *Analyze and summarize your assessment findings. What in the data jumped out?*

Analysis of the data indicates that the withdraw rates significantly impact the overall success rates in multiple departments and among particular demographic groups. The withdraw rate is a known problem for online classes which comprise more than 50% of our largest program, Spanish. This is a complex problem to address since it is shared by all online programs. The impact on particular demographic groups is magnified by the very small numbers involved. It is questionable whether we should be targeting such small groups for intervention.

For example, in the French program, French 101A students were assigned video tutorials and follow up exercises on grammar portions of several lessons prior to in-class presentation of the same material. The grammar was then presented after the due date for the tutorial work and online activities associated with it. Testing of this material followed the in class presentation and regular in-class work associated with the material. Test results following these grammar sections were then compared to the previous semester's class results in which the online work was assigned simultaneously with the in class presentation (ie. students could wait for the in-class instructor presentation before doing the parallel online component).
