WHAT TO BRING:

1. Photo ID for you & spouse, if married, and original social security/ITIN cards or letters for all persons to be listed on tax return; married couples must come together.
2. W-2s, 1099s, 1098s for 2015
- 3 Other info if applicable: charitable contributions; property tax bill; DMV registration bill; childcare provider info; childcare expenses; college expenses; health insurance information; interest paid on student loans (1098-E) and landlord info.
3. For direct deposit and a faster refund, bring a voided check or bank routing number & account numbers (not deposit or withdrawal slip) and/or pre-paid card.
4. 2014 tax return

THEY WILL NOT PREPARE:

- Married filing separately
- Self-employment and sole propriety business with expenses over \$25,000, depreciation, loss, and office in the home
- Rental income with rental expenses
- IRA conversions
- 16 or more stock transactions
- Split state income
- 1040NR (non-resident alien)
- Other tax situations may be out of scope
