Associate in Arts in Music

The associate degree in Music offered by Ohlone College is designed to prepare students for continued study of Music at most universities. While the Core courses required in the Associate in Arts in Music will fulfill the lower division major requirements at most universities, students are advised to meet with their counselor to assess the course requirements for specific universities. This program may also enable students to develop a strong foundation in music and directly enter the industry workforce if they choose not to transfer.

This degree identifies the student as having completed the foundational courses necessary for continued study in a baccalaureate degree program or for entrance directly into the industry workforce.

Requirements for Associate in Arts Degree:

- a) Complete Major Field and Emphasis Courses with a grade of C or better.
- b) Complete Ohlone College General Education (Plan A), CSU GE (Plan B), or IGETC (Plan C) requirements. These requirements are specified in the Ohlone College catalog.
- c) Complete at least 60 degree-applicable units with a 2.0 grade point average.
- d) Complete at least 12 units at Ohlone College.

Student Learning Outcomes

1. Appraise and evaluate the development of Western music based on its relevance to musical evolution in the rest of the world.
2. Comprehend and integrate the language of written, aural, and conceptual music.
3. Demonstrate proficiency at an increasing level of mastery of his/her primary instrument.
4. Analyze and categorize extant musical compositions and, in turn, employ appropriate stylistic and historical criteria to synthesize successful original music.
5. Adapt and coordinate with other musicians in ensemble situations.
