- 15) We have disclosed to you the identity of the District's related parties and all the related party relationships and transactions of which we are aware.


**Government-specific**

- 27) Components of fund balance (nonspendable, restricted, committed, assigned, and unassigned) are properly classified and, if applicable, approved.
- 28) Deposits and investment securities and derivative instruments are properly classified as to risk and are properly disclosed.
