BIOLOGY: GENERAL

The certificate in General Biology indicates that students have successfully completed a regimen of introductory science courses including chemistry (inorganic and organic), mathematics or physics, and introductory college biology. Most of these courses are transferable and constitute a part of the freshman/sophomore core courses for the bachelor's degree in biology at baccalaureate institutions. Students gain knowledge and laboratory skills in molecular and cell biology, metabolic processes, microscopy, genetics, DNA technology, microbiology, systematics, plant and animal physiology, and evolution and ecology. This certificate prepares students for a wide range of technical positions in private industry (biotechnology, pharmaceutical and medical supply, agricultural, environmental consulting firms, etc.) or in city, state, or federal agencies. This certificate is also ideal for students planning to pursue advanced studies in biology.

Student Learning Outcomes

- Correctly operate common scientific laboratory equipment such as compound microscopes, pH meters, and spectrophotometers.
- Demonstrate an understanding of the scientific method by applying this approach to experimental situations and evaluating the meaning of experimental outcomes.
