

COVID-19 Unvaccinated Students Transition Plan

[BP 3507](#) mandates all students attending in-person classes after September 30, 2021 to be vaccinated. The following information has been prepared for students who are currently designated as not vaccinated in their Ohlone student record. Use this information to determine how to prepare for the September 30th deadline.

Options to prepare for the September 30, 2021 deadline

If you are vaccinated:

A. Uploaded your documents [at this link](#); you must do so immediately to avoid being prohibited from attending your in-person class.

If you are in the process of getting vaccinated:

- B. If you are getting vaccinated or will get vaccinated, you should reach out to your in-person instructor(s) to discuss whether it is possible for you to miss class until your vaccination regimen has been completed.
1. You will not be able to attend in-person until 2 weeks after your final vaccine has been received and your vaccination status has been cleared.
 2. Your instructor will be the final determiner of whether this is possible or they cannot accommodate your extended absence.

If you are not vaccinated:

Move to a fully online schedule

1. Drop your in-person class
2. Submit an [Electronic COVID EW Request Form](#) to receive an excused withdrawal.
3. Register for a late-start class; see an academic counselor for guidance on replacement courses

Drop your in-person classes

- C. If your preference is to drop your classes and not enroll in a replacement class follow these steps.
1. Withdraw from your class.
 2. Submit an [Electronic COVID EW Request Form](#) to receive an excused withdrawal.
