Building a Syllabus with Equity in Mind

If you've taken MQT, you've heard us talk about opening the digital front door to your classroom. One of the first interactions with your students is providing them with the Syllabus. Let's look at some examples and tips for creating a student-friendly, mobile friendly, and more engaging syllabus.

Equity-minded Language and Policies

- Center for Urban Education at USC has put together [a phenomenal tool](#) which guides you through review of your syllabus based on 6 equity-minded practices. The tool is truly fantastic and well worth the 30 minutes of your time.
- Use a conversational tone that lets the students know you about them and their success. Here are some great comparisons and examples [for student-friendly language](#).
- Consider moving student support services from the back to the front of your syllabus. Encourage students to be proactive in exploring support. Remember, not everyone feels comfortable asking questions or knows what to ask.
- Add a [technology support section](#). Don't assume students have and understand the technology and software you'll be using.
- As we've shared in previous issues, requiring the use of video whether recording or not, adds to stress for many students. Stress is a hindrance to learning. *Inspire, don't require.*

- Want to provide your students with a printable copy? Use the print command on your Canvas pages and compile them in a single pdf document. You'll maintain a single version of your syllabus. Look for the upcoming MITI on creating print versions of Canvas pages.
