


Creating an OpenCCCApply Account and Completing and Admissions Application

OpenCCCApply is the application system all 115 California Community Colleges use for their application for admissions process. Once you have created an OpenCCCApply account you can apply to any one of the California Community Colleges with one login and password.

*Please be advised that the College's themselves do not have access to OpenCCCApply to access your login and password. You must contact OpenCCC for assistance.


*High school students are required to submit a new application and permission packet each semester they intend to take classes at Ohlone College.

Social Security number is not required, but can be helpful when applying for financial aid, for locating your record later on and for ordering transcripts. 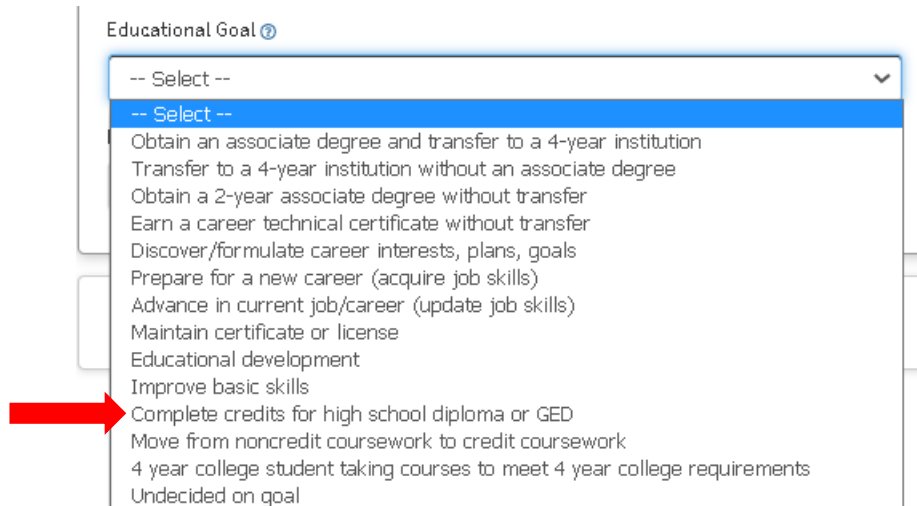

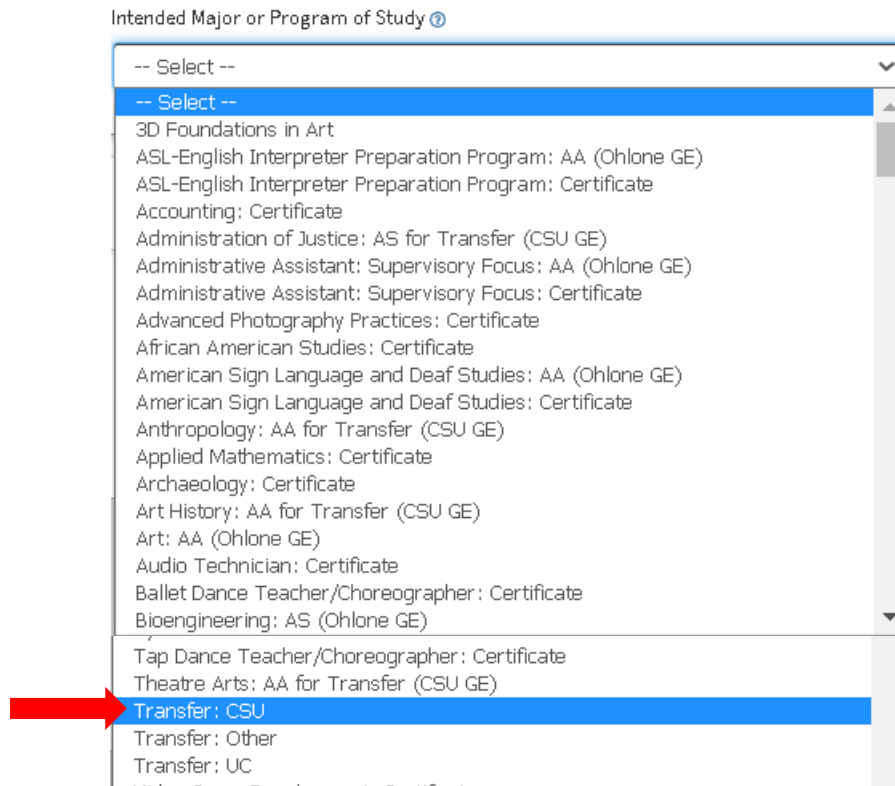
