**2019-2020 General Election Information**

**General Eligibility:**

**Candidates MUST:**

- Follow the rules contained in the ASOC Constitution and By-laws.
- Attend **ONE** ASOC Student Government General Meeting prior to running for an Executive Officer position. Attend **one** of the following meetings: **February 1<sup>st</sup>, February 8<sup>th</sup>, February 22<sup>nd</sup>, or March 1<sup>st</sup> at 10:00am- 12:00am in room 7101.** (By-laws: Article I, Section 2) Failure to attend the entire length of the meeting will result in rejection of student's application.
- Attend **ONE MANDATORY** candidate information meeting on **February 1<sup>st</sup>, February 8<sup>th</sup>, February 22<sup>nd</sup>, or March 1<sup>st</sup> 1:00pm - 2:00pm in room 7210.** (By-laws: Article I, Section 2) Failure to attend the entire length of the meeting will result in rejection of student's application.
- Upon approval of application, attend the **MANDATORY** pre-election candidates' meeting: **Friday, March 8<sup>th</sup> at 1:00pm -2:00pm in room 7210.** (By-laws: Article VII, Section 2). Regulations will be reviewed and questions will be answered. Failure to attend this meeting will result in disqualification.
- **NOT** be on academic probation at any time while in office or running for a position.

**Candidates MUST:**

- Submit a 100-word statement via e-mail to Renee Gonzales, Student Life Coordinator ([rgonzales@ohlone.edu](mailto:rgonzales@ohlone.edu)), to have views posted online to the Elections website and in the Monitor (if possible). **Deadline for the statement to be submitted via e-mail to Renee Gonzales, Student Life Coordinator, is at the Mandatory Pre-Elections Candidates Meeting on Friday, March 8<sup>th</sup> at 1:00pm in room 7210.** Statements not submitted correctly will be disqualified.

Once elected, Officers **MUST:**

- Attend the ASOC General Meetings on **Friday, April 12th and the meetings thereafter from 10:00am to Noon in Building 7/First Floor, Room 7101**
- Attend the scheduled Executive Officer's meetings TBD.
- Be able to serve a one-year term (By-Laws: Article I, Section).
- Be able to attend **ALL** of the ASOC meetings in their entirety (**Fridays, from 10:00am to Noon**) for the Fall and Spring semesters of 2019-2020 (By-Laws: Article IV, Section 2).
- Be able to attend the summer session meetings.
- Be able to attend all of the leadership retreats/ASOC trainings sponsored by ASOC and Campus Activities.
- Be enrolled in, and maintain, at least five (5) semester units (By-Laws: Article I, Section 2).
- Maintain a 2.00 cumulative GPA during their term as an officer (By-Laws: Article I, Section 2).

**Application/Petitions DEADLINE:**

The application and a minimum of seventy-five (75) Ohlone student signatures must be submitted to the Campus Activities staff at the Campus Activities Window (Building 7, Room 7210), by **4:00pm on Monday, March 4<sup>th</sup>.** **The position sought must be written on the application by the Campus Activities staff prior to filling out the petition.** If the applicant wishes to change the position sought, a new application must be obtained and all previous signatures will be forfeited. *Petitions should be turned in as early as possible to be sure that signatures and I.D. numbers are legible and valid. Petitions turned in on or just prior to the deadline that contain illegible or invalid signatures may not be eligible. (refer to By-laws: Article VII, Section 2)*
