- Make sure you have enabled the '[Embed password in invite link for one-click join](#)' option in the Zoom web portal. If this option was not enabled, you will need to cancel pre-existing meetings and reschedule them. Instructions are included in the link above.

If you have experienced a zoom-bombing, please contact your Dean. Providing day, time, course in which the bombing occurred, and any details you can remember is incredibly helpful.

DE Addendum Update

Just a reminder! Any course that is **currently** being offered online – synchronously or asynchronously – or is **scheduled to be offered** for **Spring 2021**, **must submit an addendum for local approval for Fully Online delivery**. Scheduled zoom class meetings (synchronous) are considered **FULLY ONLINE** and as such require an addendum.

Zoom, zoom, zoom – I really do have an outline of other topics to share; however, this week's Zoom software update is critical for everyone. The update comes with additional security programming AND there are added features that are available to all. For example, greet your students or colleagues with some video window dressing using the new video filters.

Once in a Zoom meeting --> Expand the menu to the right of the video icon in the Zoom task bar --> Select "Choose Video Filter" --> and scroll through the options. Don't see "choose video filter"? You need to [update your zoom desktop app](#) to 5.3.0. You'll need to update Zoom apps downloaded to all your devices.

So PLEASE check your Zoom settings AND upgrade to version 5.3.0. and we'll talk about a new topic next week.
