“Noncredit courses and programs complement Ohlone College’s mission to provide high quality educational and career pathways by offering tuition-free course and program opportunities to diverse, nontraditional, and traditionally underserved populations throughout the Tri City area. Noncredit certificates provide an effective option for advancing the educational, career, and personal success of students at Ohlone College.”

- ▶ By 2024, increase noncredit enrollments to 100 FTES.
- ▶ By Spring 2022, increase the number of noncredit certificates offered by 50% over the number offered in fall 2020, from 16 to 24.

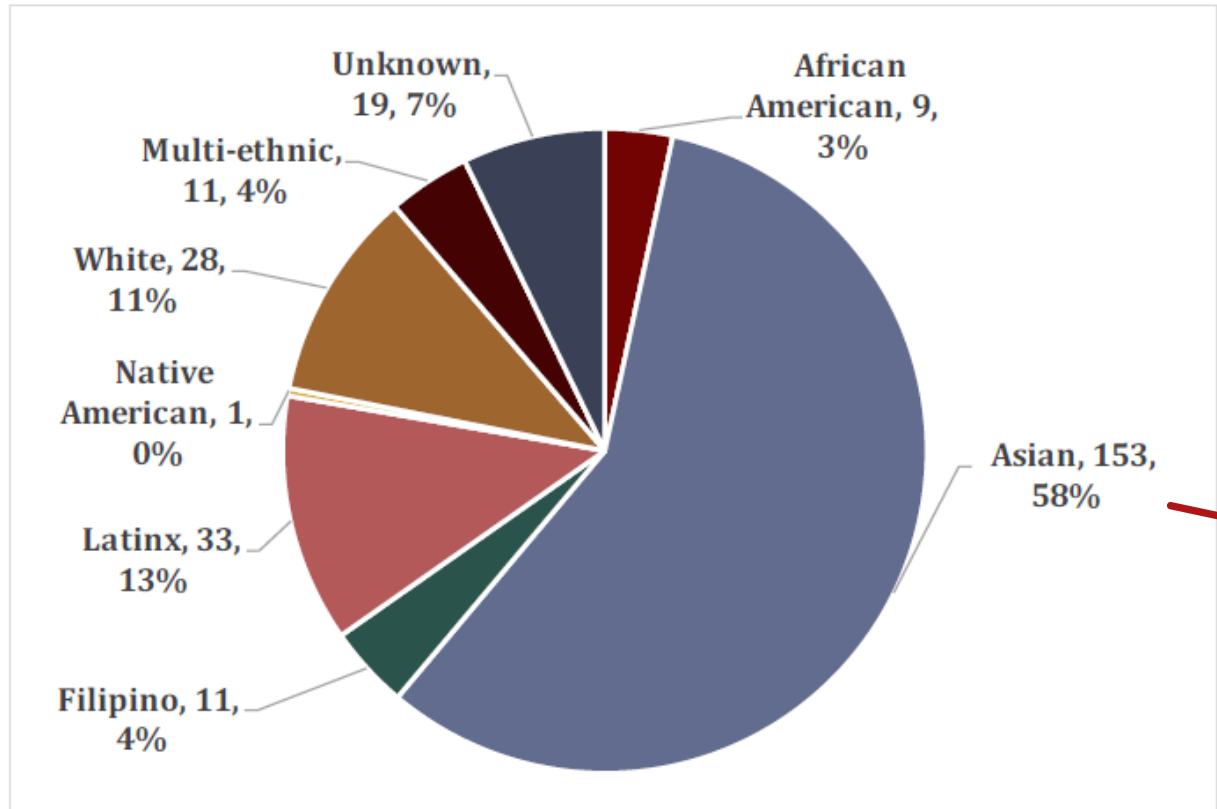
