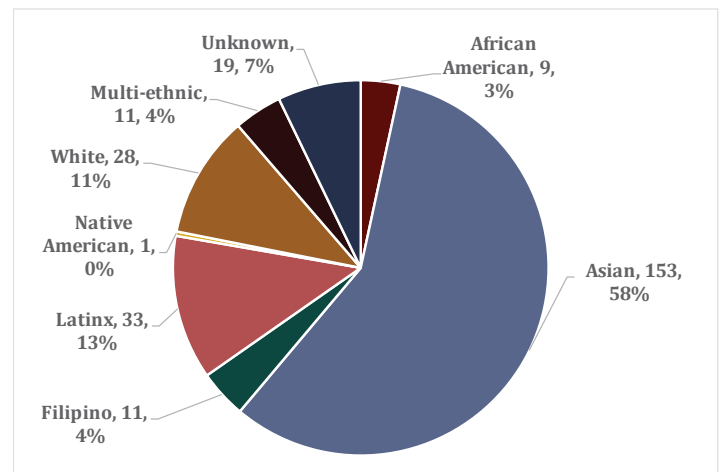
#### STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS
